DONATIONS AND ON-GOING FUNDING WITHIN THE PARISH

Dear All,

I have been asked by the Parish Advisory Committee (PAC) to provide some information on the current position dealing with the one-off donations for the work which will be undertaken on the Presbytery, and the on-going fund raising.

The money that was given for the work on the Presbytery has been ring-fenced and this means it will only be used for work for which it was given. We have obtained a number of building quotes and have now engaged the services of a builder. This means the work on the Presbytery will commence shortly.

The Church Fundraising Group and the Hall and Presbytery Fundraising Group have merged. Members of the team are in the process of completing an application for funding from the National Heritage Memorial Fund which distributes funds on behalf of the Department for Culture, Media and Sport. Liz Mayo is the lead name dealing with this application which will be submitted by the 30th January 2015.

The Social Activities and Fundraising Group have been busy raising funds through a number of events which have taken place. Members of the team have been co-ordinating and running a number of social gatherings to raise additional funds for the Parish. They have also put together a variety of social events that will take place over the next few months, such as an afternoon tea dance, quiz, choir, race night, sixties disco and a coffee morning for Mother's day. Please contribute and support these events as they bring us together as a community and at the same time raise funds for repairs and work that takes place within the Parish.

As many of you may be aware the Parish jumble sales that take place throughout the year raise a number of

funds. These funds and the distribution of the money raised is regularly reported within the news-letter.

There will be a monthly report in the news-letter outlining the collections, gift-aid, standing orders and donations. This will also illustrate any short-fall in meeting the Parish running costs.

On behalf of the PAC I would like to thank everyone involved who has contributed and continues to contribute to the raising of funds for the Parish.
