RCT SCHOOL TRANSPORT CONSULTATION

RCT has begun its consultation on proposals to introduce charges for all discretionary transport. This would mean a £1.75 per day charge for every pupil who uses RCT transport to attend Cardinal Newman, with free school meal children paying £1. It is essential that as many people as possible respond to this consultation.

All of the Church schools in RCT are against these proposals. We have written to every Councillor, Assembly Member and Member of Parliament outlining our concerns. We would urge you to also contact your local politicians to express your concerns. It is important that Councillors and other politicians realise the impact that these changes will have on parents and families.
