**GRANT APPLICATIONS FOR CHURCH RENOVATION & REPAIR AND PARISH FUNDRAISING** Our application in January to the Roof Repair Fund (RRF) was not successful but the fund will be available again at the end of November when we will be able to re-apply. We will be informed of the outcome in May 2016. If our application is successful the work will commence as soon as possible after that date. There are other funds that we can apply for but not until we have received a decision from the RRF.

I know that as a parish community we have been very busy trying to raise funds. Details of previous and ongoing fundraising events are displayed on the noticeboard in the narthex. In 2014 we raised over £12,000. This included £3754 donated for essential repairs to the presbytery. Gift aided donations have ensured that further funds have been received by our parish.

So far this year we have raised just under £4000, including **£200 achieved at the recent Sunday Coffee Morning**. Thanks to all who supported and helped with this. We appreciate all your support. Long may it continue!
