CANON PATRICK DALY

For several months now – ever since the Canon was unable to celebrate Mass with the rest of the congregation in all Hallows, we have been praying for Canon Daly. As you know he was admitted to the Royal Glamorgan Hospital during the summer, was allowed to come back to the presbytery and then had to be readmitted to the Royal Glamorgan. I announced, a few weeks ago, that the plan was that he would be receiving physiotherapy and when he was well enough he would be taken to a Nursing Home near his family home in Ireland. I also said last week that he would be moving to Ireland next Tuesday. This is still the plan.

Canon, or “Paddy” as he is known amongst the priests of this Archdiocese, has served here for over 60 years. I met him over 33 years ago. He officiated at my brother’s wedding in Newport in 1979. For me as a new priest, Paddy was one of the most welcoming priests of the Archdiocese. His hospitality is renowned. He still wants me “to call in, have coffee, stay for a meal”.

Paddy’s family have been here and will be preparing to take him to the Nursing Home in Ireland next Tuesday. Obviously our thoughts and prayers will be with him on his journey to Ireland – and then as he settles into his new home. I hope that his family will know that they will always have a warm welcome in this part of God’s creation – especially when Ireland play Wales! I’m sure that Canon Paddy is already planning the teams! We wish you well Paddy and we say a huge “Thank You” for the immense contribution to the life of the Catholic Church here in South Wales that you have made.
