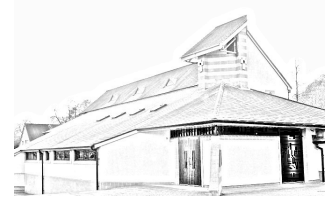

## THE JUBILEE YEAR OF MERCY

**CONFESSION: THE SACRAMENT OF MERCY** Holy Doors will be open in every diocese in England and Wales for the 'Year of Mercy' but we all have access to a door of mercy. The door to the Confessional - there's one in every parish - gives Catholics the opportunity to experience God's forgiveness in the Sacrament of Reconciliation.

The Year of Mercy gives us a chance to discover anew the loving mercy of God during this Jubilee year: when we open this door, we are called higher than our sins and defects. In going to Confession more frequently, we see more clearly all we are called to be. We are called to holiness.

Pope Francis reminds us that in this sacrament we meet Jesus ready to embrace us in all of our need with

*Gospel Acclamation: Alleluia, alleluia! Come, Holy Spirit, fill the hearts of your faithful and kindle in them the fire of your love. Alleluia!*

his grace and mercy. Pope Francis asks people: 'How long is it since you went to Confession? A week? A month? A year? Longer? Don't delay a single day if it has been a long time'.
