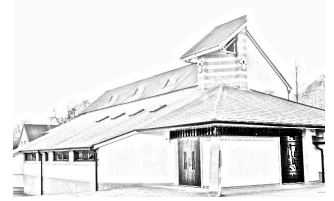

family. She converted to Catholicism and became a Carmelite nun. Her work in the Arts and Crafts style can be seen in Llanarth, Llandoverly, Holywell and churches, convents, monasteries and cathedrals in England and Scotland, as well as in Australia, Italy and the USA. She continued to design stained glass windows throughout her life. There is a special exhibition of her work in Shrewsbury Museum until January.
