World Day of Prayer for Vocations – Sunday 7th May

This is the Centenary year of the Fatima apparitions, and the World Apostolate of Fatima (WAF) England and Wales National Pilgrim Virgin statue, and relics of Blessed Jacinta and Francisco Marto, will be visiting numerous Cathedrals and churches this summer, including St David's Cathedral in Cardiff from 6-7 May 2017.
