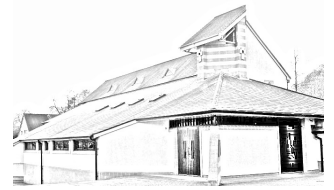

Confirmation 2019 – Confirmation will take place on Friday 31st May, at All Hallows Parish. Enrolment forms and dates are available in the narthex of both parishes.
