### **Lenten Talks at the Cornerstone**

12th April - Fr Bernard Sixtus

All talks will have a soup and a roll lunch, all donations welcome.

**On Saturday, June 15th this year**, Sherry Weddell, the world-renowned American author and evangelist, is coming to our Diocese to speak on her extensive research into the 'thresholds' or 'stages' that people go through when becoming disciples of Jesus Christ. This is based on her years of research and experience between 1993 and 2012. The cost of the day is £75 per person including lunch, tea and coffee. Parishes in the Diocese are expected to pay this cost for people wishing to attend. Booking forms may be found on the Archdiocesan website and at the back of the Church

Sherry Weddell has requested that all delegates on the day arrive with a working knowledge of her work. With that in mind, parishes across the Diocese have set up 'Forming Intentional Disciples' (FID) groups and are reading and discussing her book. Alan de Ste Croix will be leading one in St Dyfrig's parish hall from the 2nd Sunday of Easter (28th April) from 1 to 2pm for 6 weeks.

**The Archdiocese of Cardiff Family Life Commission** are organising a training day for all those interested in either starting a Bereavement Support Group in their Parish or those who have joined a group over the last year. The course will be one day and will be held at the Pastoral Resource Centre on **Saturday 6th July**. The cost of the course will be £25 and this will include all materials and lunch.

There will also be a day for existing groups on **22nd June**. This will give people the opportunity to share their ideas, worries and resources. There will also be an input from **Papyrus**, A charity working to raise the awareness of young suicide and support available. <https://papyrus-uk.org/>

### **General Data Protection Regulations and updating Parish Directory**

Dear All

I'm in the process of updating the Parish Directory. Since the last update the legislative provisions dealing with the protection and management of personal data has changed. The General Data Protection Regulation (GDPR) came into effect on the 25th May 2018. One of the changes introduced by the GDPR relates to 'consent.' This means that any personal data used for the Parish directory needs written consent from individuals to be included in the Parish Directory.

In order for us to comply with the GDPR we will need to obtain consent from each individual that will be included in our Parish Directory through a data collection form. Each individual must sign and date this form which demonstrates their informed consent. If we obtain the personal data electronically, e.g. by email then, by the very fact that you provide consent by email this will suffice.

If you are currently listed in the Parish Directory I will be contacting you, either by post or by email. I will ask you to confirm your personal details, the listing of your Parish activity and explain how we intend using this information in the Directory.

If you are **NOT** currently listed as a lead name in the Parish Directory but wish to be included, please provide your contact details and a brief outline of your Parish activity. Leave these details in the Parish Advisory Committee (PAC) suggestion box located in the Narthex or give them to a member of the PAC.
