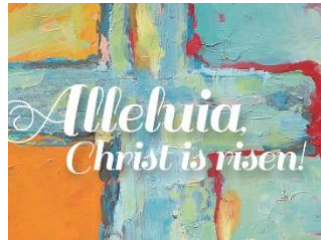

Confirmation 2019 – candidates will resume their preparation on Tuesday 30th April, 6 pm in St. Dyfrig's Hall.

On Saturday, June 15th this year, Sherry Weddell, the world-renowned American author and evangelist, is coming to our Diocese to speak on her extensive research into the 'thresholds' or 'stages' that people go through when becoming disciples of Jesus Christ. This is based on her years of research and experience between 1993 and 2012. The cost of the day is £75 per person including lunch, tea and coffee.
