## ST. DYFRIG'S NEWS

### Church Roof Repairs



The contractor, Taliesin, hopes to erect the scaffolding in the week beginning May 20th. They think it will take approx. 1 week to erect the scaffold. There will be a period of time to assess the area for asbestos containing materials. The asbestos testing should take a couple of weeks to obtain results, should the results be returned to demonstrate that there are no problems, works are expected to commence in earnest on the 3rd June 2019. Based upon the programme duration of 16 weeks, the completion date would be 6th September 2019. We'll keep you updated.

We have also been advised that because of noise during the week we will not be using the church for morning prayer and mass on Wednesdays and Fridays while the building work is going on. From the week beginning 20th May prayer and Mass will take place in the annex of the hall. The weekend masses will not be affected and neither will the arrangements for weddings and funerals.

**MISSIO RED BOXES** - The total raised for 2018 by St Dyfrig's Red Box holders was £1297.10 - another excellent achievement; the figure is up on the previous year's total of £1235.51. On the noticeboard in the Narthex (other end of the Prayer Wall), are the details of the money raised by each of the Churches in
