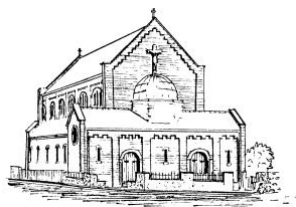

## NEWS FOR ALL

In adopting a new convention, the Diocese has decided to use the approach of other mainstream dioceses by utilising the area/district of the parish as the first part of the email address. As such, St. Dyfrig's new email address is now [treforest@rcadc.org](mailto:treforest@rcadc.org).

This change will not affect the way you use the system and emails sent to [st.dyfrigtreforest@rcadc.org](mailto:st.dyfrigtreforest@rcadc.org) will still be delivered. The biggest change will be for senders of emails to yourselves. When they hit reply, the new email address will show. And the Displayname is no longer From: St Dyfrig but From: Treforest Parish - St. Dyfrig. In 12 months time we will formally retire the [st.dyfrigtreforest@rcadc.org](mailto:st.dyfrigtreforest@rcadc.org) handle, which should give people enough time to get used to the new format. Key to this will be your own advertising of the fact on your letterheads, newsletter etc. Also it is worth noting that as of **September 1st** no other email systems/addresses should be utilised for official Diocesan/Parish business.
