My experience of the Eucharistic Ministry.

When I was first asked to become a Eucharistic Minister, quite a while ago now, my first reaction was 'I am not worthy to do that'. The priest in question replied very promptly, 'Quite right. You are not. Nobody is. But I am asking you to be of service to your Parish.' I thought this over and prayed about it.

Several things occurred to me. Is any human being worthy to hold the Body and Blood of Christ in their hands? Are any of us worthy to receive him into our

bodies? The answer was definitely no. It is all the free gift of Jesus Christ himself who offered us his Body and Blood on the cross so that we could again live in God's Kingdom. He left the gift of himself, transformed from the bread and wine, to nourish us and enable us to become just that little bit closer to that complete being he created us to be. Before we receive him in Holy Communion, we all say together, Priest and people alike, 'Lord I am not worthy that you should enter under my roof, but only say the word and my soul shall be healed.' So no, none of us is worthy, but the Lord wants to gift us with his grace.

The other thing I asked myself was, how will those who can't come to Mass receive Holy Communion regularly if a Eucharistic Minister doesn't take it to them? Who will bring me Holy Communion if and when I am in that position? The people who were doing this in the Parish certainly didn't see themselves as any more worthy than anyone else, but wanted to help others to receive Jesus, in the same way as those lucky enough to be able to come to Mass receive Him. And through the ministry of those who help to distribute Holy Communion at Mass, we are able to receive Jesus in both the Bread and the Wine.

So all in all, I became very thankful for those people who said yes to the invitation from the Priest. The next time I was asked, I was able to say yes also. And I am happy to admit that it has been the most humbling, uplifting and enriching experience of my life.

CHILDREN'S LITURGY - This weekend is the final children's liturgy of the school year. Many thanks to our loyal teams who lead our children in well-prepared presentations of the Word in a manner suitable to their age and understanding. Children are as important as the adults in our congregation as Jesus himself showed. In the midst of his disciples, who, on at least one occasion, had wanted to send the children away {Matthew 19:14}, Jesus took a little child and said to them, "Anyone who welcomes this little child in my name, welcomes me; and anyone who welcomes me welcomes the one who sent me". {Luke 9:47-48}.
