Church Roof Repairs

The large crane returned to the car park last week and the coping stones have now been repaired and replaced along with new lead and re pointing to some of the brickwork. New stone crosses were also made as the old ones were too damaged to be returned to the roof. Once the new crosses were blessed by Fr Allan, they were lifted to the roof and fixed into position. There are a few small works left that need to be completed.

Since this work has started, it has been discovered that the five stained glass windows above the Altar are also in need of repair. This was not included in the original works specified in the Grant so permission from the Heritage Lottery has been sought to complete these repairs. The work involves taking down the scaffolding and re positioning it around the end of the church so the workmen can repair the seals in the stained glass windows. Although this is not big task, there is considerable cost involved in moving the scaffolding, hence the need to seek permission from the Heritage Lottery as this was not accounted for in the original budget.

Recent updates from the Architect and the contractors assure us that all the works should be completed on schedule.

Over the weeks, photographs of the on-going work on the Church roof have been on display on the Heritage Lottery board in the Narthex. Replaced photographs are pinned on the reverse of the board if you missed them first time around.
