CATECHESIS – PASSING ON FAITH IN THE THIRD MILLENNIUM

Pope Francis encourages us to rethink how we pass on what we believe to others. He is not changing the message but asking the messenger to change. What

does that mean? In our day together we will consider three questions:

Does what we currently do in our parishes actually work, not just in terms of what we pass on, but how?

Can we reconsider what 'conversion in hearts and minds' is like and how that affects how we approach catechesis?

How does this affect who we are as 'missionary catechists'?

The sessions are full of insights from our scriptures, Church teaching and the Saints. You don't have to be a catechist to attend, but during the sessions we hope you will enjoy the possibility that you are one, you have always been one, and why you want to be one.

David writes: Our aims are

greater knowledge and confidence about who a catechist is and what a catechist does.

a better understanding of strong pastoral strategies for catechesis.

clarity about missionary approaches to catechesis.

enjoyment of the days, leaving glad you came and excited about the future.

The sessions can be attended as a 'Specialist Module' for the Catholic Certificate in Religious Studies (CCRS) Course, or as a stand-alone course for a Diocesan Catechists' Certificate. Cost for the 2-day course is included in the course fee for those following the complete CCRS Course and £15 for other participants.

The launch of the Year of the Word takes place on 30th September, the feast of St. Jerome.
