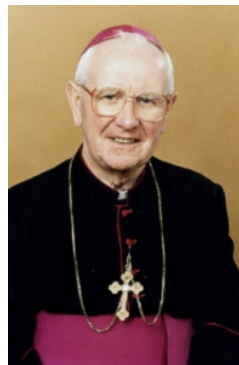

On November 18th, Fleur Dorrell from the Bishops' Conference will be coming to Cardiff to speak about the 'Year of the God Who Speaks', to the Laity on **Monday, November 18th at 6.30pm in the Cornerstone**, Charles Street, Cardiff CF10 2SF and to the Clergy on Tuesday, November 19th. Please note the change of time. Fleur is coming from London to speak to the parishioners of the Diocese and it would be excellent if we could give her a really good welcome.

The First Sunday of Advent sees the launch of the Year of the Word, under the title of, *The God Who Speaks*. The Year marks the 10th anniversary of Pope Benedict XVI's *Verbum Domini* on 'The Word of the Lord', as well as coinciding with the 1,600 anniversary of St. Jerome's death.

To celebrate the opening of the Year of the Word, there will be Solemn Evening Prayer and Benediction at Cardiff Cathedral at 3.30 pm, presided over by Archbishop George. During the celebration, copies of the Gospel of St. Matthew will be given out to the congregation, as a reminder that scripture is at the centre of everything that the Church does. Evening Prayer and Benediction will be led by the students and staff of St. Alban's High School, Pontypool.
