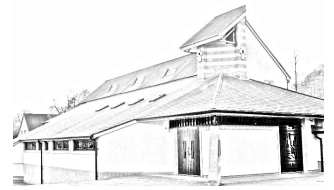

Thank you to everyone who bought wine at Christmas from Jay. He has raised a total of £225.75 towards the on-going repairs to the church.

We now have a defibrillator installed in the church grounds - it is fully working and ready for use. We are going to arrange two training sessions for both parishioners and hall users, once these dates have been arranged we will let everyone know. In the meantime, should an emergency arise, phone 999 and say the defibrillator is positioned at the rear of St Dyfrig's Presbytery, CF37 1DB, and you will be given an access code and the ambulance service will automatically be notified.

Thank you to everyone who came to help set up the hall for the weekend services, and also to put everything away. The rail with the albs and vestments has been moved to the foyer at the back of the hall. This gives the altar servers more room to prepare for mass and also frees up some space in the annex making it less congested around the door to the annex.

The door to the electrical cupboard in the annex is now lockable and the small cupboard used for storing various items used in the daily services as well as the weekend masses (chalices, candlesticks, prayer books etc.) has been placed in there. Please make sure all valuable items are returned there after each service or mass.

Any parishioners who would like to help set up the hall in preparation for the weekend masses are invited to meet at 10.30am on Saturday mornings in the hall. And any parishioners are very welcome to meet again on Monday mornings at 10.15 to put everything away again.

Sacrament of Reconciliation – due to the Church being out of use, the Sacrament will still be available at the usual time. A private space will be available on the stage in the hall. Alternatively, you can make an appointment to see Father Allan in the Presbytery.
