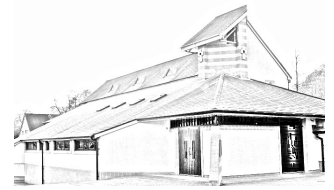

**Thursday of the Lord's Supper** – Exodus 12:1-8, 11-14

**Good Friday Passion of the Lord** – Isaiah 52:13-53:12, Hebrews 4:14-16; 5:7-9, John 18:1-19:42

First Reading Isaiah 50:4-7; Second Reading Philippians 2:6-11

Gospel Matthew 26:14-27:66

Psalm: My God, my God, why have you forsaken me?

Gospel Acclamation: Praise to you O Christ, king of eternal glory:

Christ was humbler yet, even to accepting death, death on a cross.

But God raised him high and gave him the name which is above all names.

Praise to you O Christ, king of eternal glory.

**Saturday** On Holy Saturday the Church awaits at the Lord's tomb in prayer and fasting, meditating on his Passion and Death and on his Descent into Hell, and awaiting his Resurrection. The Church abstains from the sacrifice of the Mass in anticipation by night of the Resurrection when the time comes for paschal joys.
