### **THE EASING OF THE LOCKDOWN AND THE REOPENING OF CHURCHES.**

I am sure that we are all wondering when this will take place and how it will happen. What exactly will we have to do in order to stop the coronavirus from spreading? We have now received information from the Bishop's Conference of England and Wales with regards to the reopening of churches for private prayer. At the moment the guidance is solely for private prayer. There will be many things that will have to be put in place before the churches are opened. The information says that that we will need to assemble a team of volunteers. It says that priests alone will not be able to manage the reopening of churches on their own. This team should not include those who have been instructed to shield themselves nor those from groups considered vulnerable to coronavirus. The various instructions involve such things a putting signs in place that will direct people in and out of the church, they will tell them where they can sit and how to self-distance. It will also be necessary for TWO stewards to be present while the church is open. these are to ensure that people sanitise their hands and distance themselves.

Please remember in your prayers the following who died recently: Nora Coakley, Ingrid Kennedy, Maureen Scanlon and Ken Bond.

Nora, Ingrid and Maureen were all residents at the Ty Hafod Care Home and were visited by Eucharistic

Consequently we will have to set up teams of volunteers from both parishes. The volunteers should come from those who do not have to shield themselves or those who are not vulnerable to the virus.
