THE REOPENING OF THE CHURCHES AFTER THE LOCKDOWN

It seems that the builders have more or less finished this stage of the work in St Dyfrig's. There are a few loose ends to be cleared up and then it will need to be made ready, first of all, for private prayer and then, at a later stage, the celebration of Mass and public worship. This will mean that we will not need to use the parish hall for Mass.

As I said in last week's newsletter there are many things that need to be done before the churches can be reopened. Just to give you an idea of what needs to be done, signs have to be put up which direct people to the entrance and the exit of the churches. Benches will be cordoned off to comply with the self-distancing regulations. Hand sanitisers will be at the entrance and exit of the churches. A sort-of "one way" system will need to be put in place. We will also need a team of volunteers (who do not show symptoms of having the coronavirus, are not self-isolating or in contact with anyone who is, and are within the recommended age groups). The team will need to act as stewards while the church is open to make sure that those who come in to pray keep a distance from one another and use the cleaning materials as directed. If anyone is able to help in this respect could you please contact me, Fr Allan? The number of volunteers will determine how long and when the churches will be open. As you can see it's not simply a case of opening the church doors. It seems that not all churches in the Archdiocese will open at the same time. I'm afraid we will need a little more patience!
