AN UPDATE ON THE REOPENING OF THE CHURCHES.

As you will know All Hallows is now open on Tuesdays and Thursdays from 10.00am - 12noon. I thank Neil, the cleaners and the stewards for making this possible.

There has been a slight delay with St Dyfrig's because of the building work, the electrical work and the installation of a system that will allow us to stream masses on the internet. Also, finding cleaners who would be able to deep clean the church hasn't been easy. However, the plan is that this work will be finished by the end of this week (10th July). Hopefully then we will be able to move the altar furniture back and get the church prepared for visitors who wish to make private prayer. I will let you know when the church is reopened through the parish website and social media. We still haven't been given any information about celebrating mass. The problems here seem to be the mechanics of coping with the number of people who attend mass and social distancing. When we have this information we will let you know.

Pope Francis has named Archbishop Claudio Gugerotti as Apostolic Nuncio to Great Britain.

Claudio Gugerotti was born in Verona, Italy, in 1955 and ordained a priest of the Diocese of Verona in 1982. He studied Eastern Languages and Sacred Liturgy and was a professor of Patristics, Eastern Liturgy at the Institute of Ecumenical Studies in Verona from 1981 to 1985.

In 1985, he was appointed as an official working at the Congregation for the Eastern Churches and he became its Undersecretary in 1997. He has also taught at the Pontifical Oriental Institute.

On 7 December 2001, Pope St John Paul II appointed him Apostolic Nuncio to Georgia and to Armenia. He was also subsequently appointed Apostolic Nuncio to Azerbaijan on 13 December.

He received his episcopal consecration by Pope St John Paul on 6 January 2002 appointing him to the Titular See of Ravello.

Pope Benedict XVI appointed him Apostolic Nuncio to Belarus in 2011 and Pope Francis appointed him Apostolic Nuncio to Ukraine in 2015.

The previous Nuncio to Great Britain, Archbishop Edward Adams, retired in January 2020.

St. Dyfrig's News

The Hall Development Group have been busy working over the last couple of months on a grant application to the Welsh Office. Last week we heard the application had been successful and we have been awarded a grant of £25,000 from the Welsh Office's Community Facilities Programme. This money will be used to replace the big front doors of the hall and as many windows as the funds will allow. As with the church, the Hall is a Grade II listed building and as such, there are certain conditions placed on the work to be carried out. Again as with the church, the biggest cost will be scaffolding needed to reach the windows in line with health and safety regulations. We are hoping to start the work as soon as possible but we have to seek three quotes and all details of the work to be undertaken must be sanctioned by the Archdiocese.

The Hall Development Group is continuing to apply for other grants as and when they become available to carry out further work needed to be completed on the hall.

SVP Support Lines - St. Dyfrig's SVP is in a difficult position at the moment for obvious reasons. We can no longer visit those people we usually see and as but two of our Society are in the 'vulnerable' category of people, there is little else we can do other than telephone and keep in contact with those we know. However, we would like to make ourselves available to other who we may not know. Therefore, below is a list of names and phone numbers. If you or anyone else you know is isolated and lonely and would

welcome a chat, we are here on the end of the phone. If we can help in any other way we will, but obviously within the Government guidelines. Our love and prayers to you all. Keep well, keep safe, stay at home.
