Reopening of St Dyfrig's and the building work

Now, both All Hallows and St Dyfrig's are open for private prayer. The opening times are as follows: ALL HALLOWS Tuesdays and Thursdays from 10.00am - 12 noon. ST DYFRIG'S Wednesday from 10.00am - 12 noon and Fridays and Sundays from 2.00pm - 4.00pm. I would like to thank Neil Spiller for all the work that has been necessary to make this possible. The Blessed Sacrament will be exposed on Sunday afternoon during the time the church is opened.

The scaffolding at the front of the church has now been taken down. The golden dome can now be seen in all its glory! (Gold was the original colour when the church was built in 1927). A stone mason will be coming in the next few days to do some repair work on the arches above the front doors. At long last and after contacting at least 4 companies, the pathway from the car park to the front door of the church has been re-laid. It had been a health hazard for many years. It is now much safer and also includes a drain that takes water away from the walls of the presbytery.

Although we have the equipment to "stream" mass there are still a few things that the experts need to sort out. As soon as this is done I will begin saying mass in the church and details as to how to log in will be given out.

The gift aid envelopes are now available. They are on the stewards' tables in the narthex and may be collected during the church opening times. If this is a

The Hall Development Group have been busy working over the last couple of months on a grant application to the Welsh Office. Last week we heard the application had been successful and we have been awarded a grant of £25,000 from the Welsh Office's

Community Facilities Programme. This money will be used to replace the big front doors of the hall and as many windows as the funds will allow. As with the church, the Hall is a Grade II listed building and as such, there are certain conditions placed on the work to be carried out. Again as with the church, the biggest cost will be scaffolding needed to reach the windows in line with health and safety regulations. We are hoping to start the work as soon as possible but we have to seek three quotes and all details of the work to be undertaken must be sanctioned by the Archdiocese.

The Hall Development Group is continuing to apply for other grants as and when they become available to carry out further work needed to be completed on the hall.

SVP Support Lines - St. Dyfrig's SVP is in a difficult position at the moment for obvious reasons. We can no longer visit those people we usually see and as but two of our Society are in the 'vulnerable' category of people, there is little else we can do other than telephone and keep in contact with those we know. However, we would like to make ourselves available to other who we may not know. Therefore, below is a list of names and phone numbers.
