The Restarting of Public Mass – We have now been given the instructions for mass in public. A lot of things are already in place however, there are still more things to put in place. Most of the instructions are to do with cleaning, sanitizing and keeping a distance from one another. However, all of the ministers for mass must be under 70 and they must not show any signs of coronavirus. The number of people who can attend mass will be fewer than the pre-lockdown congregations. The Hall Development Group have been busy working over the last couple of months on a grant application to the Welsh Office. Last week we heard the application had been successful and we have been awarded a grant of £25,000 from the Welsh Office's

Community Facilities Programme. This money will be used to replace the big front doors of the hall and as many windows as the funds will allow. As with the church, the Hall is a Grade II listed building and as such, there are certain conditions placed on the work to be carried out. Again as with the church, the biggest cost will be scaffolding needed to reach the windows in line with health and safety regulations. We are hoping to start the work as soon as possible but we have to seek three quotes and all details of the work to be undertaken must be sanctioned by the Archdiocese.

The Hall Development Group is continuing to apply for other grants as and when they become available to carry out further work needed to be completed on the hall.

SVP Support Lines - St. Dyfrig's SVP is in a difficult position at the moment for obvious reasons. We can no longer visit those people we usually see and as but two of our Society are in the 'vulnerable' category of people, there is little else we can do other than telephone and keep in contact with those we know. However, we would like to make ourselves available to other who we may not know. Therefore, below is a list of names and phone numbers.
