The Archdiocesan Building Resilience Project

Some of the PAC and some members of the Hall development group, along with Fr Allan, met with the three new appointees to the Archdiocesan Building Resilience Project last week. The project will last for 3 years and will specifically support four parishes, two in Newport, one in Merthyr and St Dyfrig's. The aim of the project is to help develop long-term plans for each of the parishes to ensure each of the churches and associated buildings have a continued use and plans for future development. The support will be in the form of sourcing volunteers for various projects, sourcing means of funding which we can apply for and admin support and IT support for completing application forms and other documentation.

Lauren, Martin and Gareth have a wide background of skills – conservation, architecture, enterprise, IT, fundraising and volunteering schemes and they are keen to work with us on the development of the Hall project as well as the next phase of the refurbishment of the church.

Because they are going to be working across the four parishes, we will have limited contact with them but we are hoping to make the most of what they can offer for all 3 buildings on the St Dyfrig's site.

SVP Support Lines - St. Dyfrig's SVP is in a difficult position at the moment for obvious reasons. We can no longer visit those people we usually see and as but

two of our Society are in the 'vulnerable' category of people, there is little else we can do other than telephone and keep in contact with those we know. However, we would like to make ourselves available to other who we may not know. Therefore, below is a list of names and phone numbers. If you or anyone else you know is isolated and lonely and would welcome a chat, we are here on the end of the phone.
