Do You Believe in Miracles?

Sr Briega McKenna wrote a book 'Miracles do Happen' and I would like to tell you a few. A boy about 7 was suffering from headaches and the doctor diagnosed a brain tumour. The mother was beside herself with worry. I sent her a rosary and a Padre Pio prayer card. The doctor said that he would not be able to give results for six weeks after the operation. Within two weeks the answer came – it was benign.

A dear friend was struck down with a serious illness and his grandson prayed the rosary, and now the friend is home and recovering.

The next story is about a grandson of mine who has been depressed for a long time and out of work. I never ceased to pray for him. The worry caused his parents grief. I sent him a rosary. He is much happier and so are his parents.

Our Lady said the rosary will stop wars and history tells of miracles through this prayer. If you have not already done so pick up your rosary and see the miracles happen. If you prefer to have company when you say it as I do, watch EWTN 588 Sky. Mass is at 1 pm each day followed by the rosary, 7.30 pm children's rosary which is a delight to watch. If you make a date you are more likely to keep it up, there is also Word on Fire, YouTube, and Rosary Zoom Lourdes. We have been closer now spiritually through the 'phone, text, letters and it has been lovely to hear how others are and know of the sick who need our prayers. This is a time of grace if we take and use it. There is a list of numbers in the newsletter of the SVP if you want a word. I am grateful to you all and we continue to pray for each other, Fr Alan especially. Through prayer we will get through the current situation. Put a prayer in your window for people to read. My prayer is:

'Lord come to our aid,
Lord make haste and help us.'
