## A note from Fr Allan with regards to the Welsh lockdown from 23rd October to 9th November

I'm sure that you will all know by now that Wales will enter another lockdown on Friday 23rd October. This will mean, among other things, that we will be unable to celebrate masses with congregations during this time (lasting until 9<sup>th</sup> November). At the moment the only exceptions to this are funerals and weddings. Archbishop George has written to the First Minister Mark Drakeford saying that he is disappointed that churches/places of worship have been included in the latest regulations given that they have such a good record with regards to the numbers of positive cases of coronavirus. It is hoped that a decision will be made regarding the opening of churches for private prayer over the next few days. As the newsletter is usually sent by email on Wednesdays the decision regarding private prayer will be sent to the parish website and its Facebook page as soon as it is known. All of the masses during this lockdown will be streamed and the times are given at the end of the newsletter. Please keep safe and well during this time. May God Bless you all. Fr Allan
