In Memory of Rene Marenghi

Irene's funeral service took place Friday 20th November at Glyn Taff Cemetery. It was attended by several parishioners from St Dyfrig's along with members of her family. The service was conducted by Reverend Canon Eddie O'Connell from the Parish of Mary Immaculate, Mountain Ash who gave a fitting and funny eulogy for Irene. The hymns were sung from CDs.

Her father was, what was called, an Italian alien at the time of the Second World War and was being shipped in 1940 to Canada when the ship, the SS Arandora Star, was torpedoed and sunk off the coast of Ireland with a loss of over 800 lives. He was buried in Ireland but was reinterred in Glyntaff Cemetery after the end of the war. Irene and her mother ran the Rendezvous Cafe in Mill Street on the corner from Mill Street into Gelliwastad Road near to the old police station. The cafe was knocked down when the Sardis bridge was built and other road improvements made in the 70s. She loyally brought her mother to the Union of Catholic Mothers meetings each week. Irene attended mass almost every day of the week, was involved in many aspects of parish ministry: special minister of the Eucharist, counter, helper at jumble sales, etc. She was popular with all ages and could speak to children easily and they could speak to her. She had a quirky sense of humour. During the last few years as her health declined who lived in a nursing home in Aberdare.

She will be sadly missed by her faith friends.
