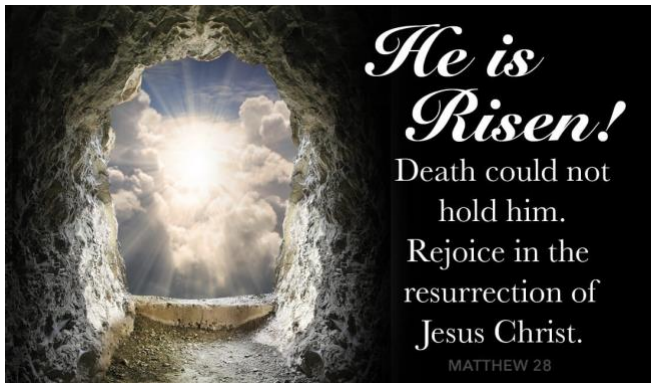

MAY I TAKE THIS OPPORTUNITY TO WISH YOU ALL A VERY HAPPY EASTER?

As the Covid 19 regulations continue we, once again, have to adjust the manner of celebrating our faith on one of the most important celebrations of the Church's year. May our more subdued Triduum and Eastertide re-energise our faith, May the different ways that we approach our faith bring us closer to God, a greater understanding of our calling and more united in our communities. A Happy Easter to you all.

For those still unable to attend Mass the following prayer is an Act of Spiritual Communion written by St Alphonsus Liguori in the 18th Century. "My Jesus, I believe that You are present in the Most Holy Sacrament. I love You above all things and I desire to receive You into my soul. Since I cannot at this moment receive You sacramentally, come spiritually into my heart. I embrace You as if You were already there and unite myself wholly to You. Never permit me to be separated from You. Amen.

## Canon William Isaac RIP

Canon William died last Sunday afternoon. He had an operation the week before but never really regained consciousness. Many of you know that William was a good friend of mine. We had met in Bargoed while we were still seminarians almost forty years ago. I was in the English College in Spain and he was due to start at the Beda College in Rome. After his ordination he served in parishes in Port Talbot, Morriston Swansea, Mountain Ash, Abercynon, Bridgend and Whitchurch, Cardiff. In several parishes we either followed one another or became neighbours. William was a very pastoral and social priest. He loved the Church. He was authentic in his faith and urged others to be the same. He was well-known for his hospitality even if he couldn't cook himself! As a good friend I can say that "he was very good at bringing out the talents in other people!" I am sure that many of you will have your own memories of Canon Isaac. His Requiem Mass will take place at St David's Cathedral, Cardiff on Thursday 8th April at 5.00pm. This will be by invitation according to the current Covid 19 regulations. He will be buried at Belmont Abbey on Friday 9th April. His burial will follow a mass at 11.30am. May he rest in peace.
