News For All

25TH ANNIVERSARY OF THE OPENING OF THE NEW CHURCH OF ALL HALLOWS, MISKIN

Unfortunately, because of the pandemic it has not been possible, so far, to celebrate this occasion as we would normally do. Any such anniversary would usually be accompanied by a concelebrated special mass with His Grace, the Archbishop as the chief celebrant and then either preceded or followed by a year of celebrations.

We could invite guests from around the Archdiocese and beyond to these celebrations. Perhaps we could invite priests who have served in the parish or who have some special connection with All Hallows. We could invite Canon Daly's family in Ireland. We could invite our Civic friends. We could incorporate a

concert by our Russian friends who have sung in the Church on several occasions into our celebrations. There could be other musical and choral events, a festival of flowers, a series of films and dramas - suggestions are welcome! There will be many parishioners who are unaware of the history of our parish. Perhaps we should have several presentations that explain this history and the development of the Catholic Faith in our area. In the aftermath of the coronavirus maybe we need to set up a series of events that will encourage people to return to Church. We might need to "top up" the faith of those of us who are already here. All of these things could be incorporated into a 25th Anniversary Year of celebrations. When the Parish Advisory Council meets next I will make sure that our 25th Anniversary is on the agenda! I knew Liz most of my life, firstly in the old St. Michael's on Wood Rd. She sat in front of me with Pat Davies (Ronan). Most of the class have kept the faith which says a lot for the teacher Mr O'Sullivan who sadly passed away at 36 years of age. Then I would see Liz in mass and would look out for what pretty hat she would be wearing that day. Next we were all into dancing and there she was with Denis, dancing in the Parish Hall, they were so glamorous and professional, put 'Strictly' to shame. Then mass every Sunday with the girls running in and out of benches, no quiet room then. How brave she was after the deaths of Sarah, Denis and Kate and on asking how she was she would just say, 'fine musn't grumble. What a lovely lady happy now, face to face with God, rest in peace.

Evelyn I got to know when I was about 20 when she asked me to babysit, she and Harry went to the cinema. I had my instructions and I carried them out and I learned a lot to help me with my own children later. She had four children then. When they came home Harry would walk me to the top of my street and wait until I got in the gate and gave a wave.

Next came me married and Ali on the way and Evelyn expecting her fifth child and we shared a mid-wife, Anne Withy who arrived on motorbike. Ali was born at 3.30 am and Anne 7 am the following morning. So, we became close friends. They were wonderful parents and after the sad accident with Ann, they

were always at the Cottage Hospital visiting, brushing her hair and talking so gently. Visiting Evelyn in Hawthorn was always a treat, hearing stories of their life together. I will always remember Harry reading at mass, especially the Psalms 'This poor man called and the Lord heard him' and 'I am sure I will see the Lord in the land of the living. I did see the Lord in Evelyn and Liz; may they rest in peace. Anne Parker.
