PLEASE NOTE ALL OF THE CHANGES THIS WEEK ESPECIALLY THAT PARISHIONERS WILL BE INVITED TO THE MASSES ON TUESDAY AND WEDNESDAY. YOU WILL NOT NEED TO RESERVE PLACES ON THESE DAYS.

THE SACRAMENT OF CONFIRMATION WILL BE CONFERRED ON 16 OF OUR YOUNG ADULTS NEXT THURSDAY 8TH JULY AT 7.00PM. This year because of the pandemic and the unusual circumstances Archbishop Stack has delegated all Parish Priests to celebrate the Sacrament in their parishes. Unfortunately we won't be able to go into the hall for light refreshments as we usually do. Also we won't be able to sing hymns and movement will be restricted in the church. We will also have to adhere to the social distancing regulations which will mean that numbers will be restricted. Candidates and their families will necessarily be allocated seats before others. I am sure that in spite of the situation it will be a lovely celebration.

Gift Aid Declarations: In order to ensure we have up to date records, if your circumstances have changed or you have moved since completing your original declaration, please contact the Parish Office treforest@rcadc.org for a new form. If you have not previously donated by Gift Aid and are a UK tax payer, you may wish to consider doing so, as the Parish can reclaim 25p from HMRC of every £1 donated, at no cost to the donor. PAYING ONE'S OFFERTORY COLLECTION BY STANDING ORDER

For those who have bank accounts this is an easy way of paying into the church collection. For gift aiders there is no more scrabbling about for the money to put in the gift aid envelope each week and for the remainder just no more scrabbling about. (I know that when the offertory plate used to come round I felt uncomfortable at not putting anything in it but now the plate does not circulate, and is unlikely to, that discomfort is no longer there.)

Anyone interested can complete the form included in this newsletter and return to their banks. The form is also available on the church's web site.

AND, if you are a taxpayer and have not already completed a Gift Aid form to enable the church to receive an EXTRA 25p from the Government for every pound you donate, at no cost to yourselves, then may I ask that you consider doing so. If, at some future point, your tax position changes and you no longer qualify as a tax payer then cancelling the gift aid is not a problem. Telephone Leigh in the church office giving your details so that he can send by email or post the Gift Aid form and standing order to you for completion and return to Leigh who will forward the standing order form onto your bank after completing the gift aid reference number on it.
