COVID REGULATIONS WITH REGARDS TO PLACES OF WORSHIP

It is now possible to make pastoral visits indoors in private dwellings. The regulations say that those involved should take all reasonable care and when the weather is favourable outdoor visiting should still be considered. With this in mind if anyone would like Fr Allan to visit for the Sacrament of the Sick or for Holy Communion you will be welcome to contact the presbytery. The Welsh Government is expected to make a further announcement on July 15th or 16th. This will then inform the Archdiocese with regards to visits by Eucharistic Ministers and parish visitors. Obviously housebound and sick parishioners will decide whether or not to allow visitors into their homes.

At the moment the rule is that a place of worship must be sanitised if there is less than 72 hours between church services. At the moment All Hallows is sanitised after Sunday morning mass and before and after additional services such as funerals. St Dyfrig's is sanitised when it is necessary. I wonder if parishioners could be aware of the need to sanitise if there is less than 72 hours between services in the church and be prepared to sanitise when needed.

In addition to our regular Sunday morning mass, as from 17th July, Mass will now be celebrated on Saturday evening alternative weeks at 6.00 p.m. at All Hallows.

It is important when booking a place for Holy Mass, you must give your name, address, telephone number and the number of people attending and your preference either **Saturday or Sunday Mass.**
Please use the Mobile telephone number 07599 155418 or text/phone.

As you are aware, we have limited seating spaces at Mass in line with the Covid regulations, if you have booked a place at mass and for some reason you are unable to attend, please could you let us know in order that the space allocated can be offered to another person. As confidence is growing, more people are coming back to mass and we are continually endeavouring to accommodate as many people as allowed within the spaces available, most weeks we have people on a reserve list in the event of cancellations.

STEWARDS AT MASS – *It is important that we have enough volunteers to act as Stewards at Mass to ensure the church is sanitised after each use in line with Covid regulations and safe environment of our churches. We need your help in joining our team of current Stewards in order for us to continue having the ability to have Holy Mass in our parish.*

We have received offers of help for Saturday Mass and we are grateful for this support and effectively we hope to have two teams of Stewards one for Saturday

Night and one for Sunday Morning masses. Bookings for Mass are only necessary for **Weekend Masses**, there is no need to pre-book for Tuesday morning Mass.
