

To book a mass for either **Saturday Night Mass at 6.00pm or Sunday at 9:15 a.m.** please contact Teresa Bressington each Friday on [07599155418](tel:07599155418) between 10.00am to 12.00pm to reserve a place at mass.

It is important when booking a place for Holy Mass, you must give your name, address, telephone number and the number of people attending and your preference either **Saturday or Sunday Mass.** **Please use the Mobile telephone number 07599 155418 or text/phone.**

As you are aware, we have limited seating spaces at Mass in line with the Covid regulations, if you have booked a place at mass and for some reason you are unable to attend, please could you let us know in order that the space allocated can be offered to another person. As confidence is growing, more people are coming back to mass and we are continually endeavouring to accommodate as many people as allowed within the spaces available.

STEWARDS AT MASS – *It is important that we have enough volunteers to act as Stewards at Mass to ensure the church is sanitised after each use in line with Covid regulations and safe environment of our churches. We need your help in joining our team of current Stewards in order for us to continue having the ability to have Holy Mass in our parish.*
