Pastor Gareth writes: THE NEEDS OF THE MANY

CAFOD, the Catholic Fund for Overseas Development, is the official charity of the Catholic Church in England and Wales for helping people in need across the globe. Twice each year CAFOD invites us to fast on a Friday in solidarity with people in need, and to make an offering towards their work. Each time this happens, they focus on a person or group which has benefitted from your donation, and this year they have chosen Dr Nasha and her team from Pakistan. Dr Nasha's mobile medical clinic gets life-saving help to where it's needed most, fast – so when her team arrived in Meera's village in Pakistan after it had been destroyed by flooding, Meera rushed to the clinic to get her children the treatment they needed.

In this weekend's gospel, we hear the story of two sons. One says he will help his father, but doesn't. The other refuses at first, but then goes and does what he is asked. We are called to consider which child of God we are. Are we the one who

says the right thing, who is full of good intentions, but somehow doesn't quite manage to follow through? Or are we the one who might make a mistake, but ultimately does what we know to be right? Let's think today about how we can put our faith into action, not simply paying lip service to the Lord, but answering his call to serve him and to love our neighbours – people like Meera – as ourselves.

A message from St Dyfrig's:

Anne Parker, nee Zanchi, died this week aged 84 years old. She was a life-long parishioner of St Dyfrig's, widow of Brian, and mother of 7 children. She was humble, loving, compassionate, understanding and had a firm belief in the power of prayer bringing before the Lord at daily mass those concerns of people she had met that morning at the bus stop. She had a particular love of the rosary and a devotion to Padre Pio whose prayer group she led here at St Dyfrig's for many years. She was a reader, minister of Holy Communion, and held prayer meetings in her home for neighbours. As a President of the St Vincent de Paul group, she was active pre covid with visits, organizing trips and, during covid, with phone calls, and lately with written messages. She was housekeeper to the priests in the presbytery – a job she loved and considered a privilege retiring at 70 years of age. When organizing the jumble sales here, she used to gather the stallholders together, before the doors opened, offering up prayers for a good crowd and that everybody would have an harmonious time. Ill health meant that, lately, her visits to this church were less frequent but she remained one of the stalwarts of the local church. 'Go to your just reward, good and faithful servant.' I know that she would be grateful if you would remember her family in your prayers.

PASTOR GARETH adds a note of his gratitude for her service as housekeeper when he first moved into St Dyfrig's in 2007.
